

WARD MEMBERS TAKE ACTION ON RESIDENTS' TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

A concerted effort on local traffic is called for, evidenced by a large number of local residents' letters and emails, ward members have received recently.

Ward Councillors, Sue Steel, John Dennis and Mike Bryan are pressing East Riding Officers for urgent consideration of this area's traffic problems. Sue is organising a Preston traffic action group which is to consider all matters connected to that community. Hedon won't be far behind.

A by-pass of Preston and Hedon is perhaps a long-term, and expensive solution, but we have put it to Traffic Officers already. However urgent action on signage etc is required, as the village's residents, and Hedon, need the traffic pressures to be relieved as a matter of urgency.

The build up of traffic, use of inappropriate roads by HGVs, speeding, general parking and parking on pavements are all causing concern in Hedon and Preston. We've had lots of letters which are all sent on to the powers that be. Officers are being made to listen and an urgent meeting has been called for.
